Lakes Valley Conference Awards:

Scholar Athlete: 10th – 12th Grade only with a 3.25 accumulative GPA

All Conference Award: JV or Varsity Bowler within top ten averages at season end for conference matches. Bowlers must have completed the minimum number of games to qualify for this award at the JV or Varsity Level.

All State Awards: Selected by the Michigan High School Bowling Coaches Association All State Committees based on the following criteria.

All State Team: First Team, Second Team, Third Team and All Academic (seniors only).

- Only athletes whose coaches or athletic directors are current members of the MHSIBCA can be nominated and eligible for this award.
- All State Teams will be determined for Divisions I, II, III and IV, by the individual bowlers final placement at States.
- Seniors only are eligible for the academic teams (3.65 GPA or higher) and dream team.
- All student athletes meeting criteria are eligible (multiple athletes from a school could make these teams). Athletes who have been suspended for an MHSAA rule violation are ineligible.
- All nominated bowlers must have bowled 13 regular season games to be eligible. Conference singles games shall be included. Invitational and other tournament games are not counted.
- Coaches must submit a final league sheet for each bowler nominated along with a completed application. The coach is required to fill out the applications and the committee must be able to reach him/her in the event that clarification is needed.
- Any information that is not verified (league sheet, transcript, etc) will not be used for point total.

All State Academic Team:

- Team Roster, must be six players who competed at MHSAA Regional Tournament.
- Minimum combined average of 3.65 on a 4.0 scale (GPA's will automatically be calculated)
- Players with all A's receive bonus points according to their grade level, (i.e. 10th graders receive 4.05, 11th graders receive 4.10, and 12 graders 4.15)
- The six individual transcripts (as of 2/1/2020) must be mailed and confirmed as received to verify grade point averages. 8th grade transcripts will be used for freshmen boys and girls.
- Teams that achieve Academic All State Status will be awarded with a certificate of achievement which will be sent to the Athletic Director. The team's name will be listed in the MHSIBCA Spring Awards Banquet Program.

Pins: based on Conference Match Games bowled in High School Season

High Game, games bowled between 200 and 219 will receive a 200 pin, games bowled between 220 and 239 will receive a 220 pin and so on

200, 220, 240, 270, 300

High Series, based on a two-game series. Series bowled between 400 and 449 will receive a 400 series pin, series bowled between 450 and 499 will receive a 450 series pin and so on
